I take this opportunity to write to you to update and clarify further recent reporting in relation to GFG/Liberty. You may have read reports that GFG/Liberty are under investigation by the SFO (Serious Fraud Office) in Britain. The Union understands at the time of writing the scope of the investigation has not been determined further the duration of any proposed investigation may take months if not years before any determination is made and whether any potential prosecutions exist.

Further conflicting reports by the media in relation to refinancing only further added to the unnecessary angst created. The Union understands notwithstanding media reportage that negotiations continue with the refinancers and GFG/Liberty. The refinancers have clearly indicated they seek to support profitable businesses and jobs.

It is disappointing that Members have been subjected to unnecessary speculation and angst. Your Union continues to support and advocate where necessary on behalf of Members and the wider community however the Union will not engage in speculation, media stunts and on going commentary based on hypotheticals.
